HOW TO ENTER

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To enter, you must be a current undergraduate student in an Australian university at the time of the competition. Students from all courses, institutions and learning streams may enter the scholarship. You must be an Australian resident and over the age of 18.

WHY THIS TOPIC?

Young drivers (17-25) represent 1/4 of all Australian road deaths, but these drivers are only 10-15% of the licenced driver population. A 17 year old driver with a P1 licence is four times more likely to be involved in a fatal crash than a driver over 26 years. We want to encourage creative thinking and reward new ideas that may help save lives.
